#### BACKGROUND

- 2009: journal hosting service is launched to support one internal journal
- 2021: launched a book hosting service & rebranded as **Edinburgh Diamond**
- 2023:
  - Two full-time members of staff: one for publishing support & one for technical support
  - 23 journals, 3 conference proceedings & 9 books

- Free of charge for staff & students of the University of Edinburgh
- Promotes excellent projects & research coming out of the University of Edinburgh
- Service board in place to help shape the service
- Fully Diamond Open Access & **Creative Commons licensed**

- Workflow training
- Ongoing technical support, migrations & upgrades

- Indexing submissions
- Annual reports & metrics
- Publishing best practice guidance. advice & policies

- Workflow management (users retain full editorial & workflow control)
- Lack of internal resource means we don't currently offer copyediting & typesetting services

## **CONCLUSIONS &** RECOMMENDATIONS

- Works needs done on raising awareness & perceived prestige of Diamond Open Access within **UK** academic communities
- A hosting service needs to be fully supported in the areas of publishing & tech - whether internally or via outsourcing
- Be transparent about what your service does and doesn't offer
- Don't grow too quickly or the service won't be sustainable and can leads to users leaving
- Keep quality in mind to ensure content can be indexed
- Remember a service needs to be robust and a viable alternative publishing route
