Concept Note

Science Europe, cOAlition S, OPERAS, and the French National Research Agency (ANR) are organising a 'Diamond Open Access Conference' on 19 and 20 September 2022 in Zadar, Croatia. The conference is organised in a hybrid format to allow participation in person, as well as remotely.
