

New Publication from Science Europe on Reasons to Care about Integrity in Research (22 June 2015)

A new brochure has been published by Science Europe's Working Group on Research Integrity.

The brochure, entitled '*Seven Reasons to Care about Integrity in Research*', sets out the key reasons why research organisations care about promoting research integrity amongst their community.

These are that research integrity: safeguards the foundations of science and scholarship; maintains public confidence in researchers and research evidence; underpins continued public investment in research; protects the reputation and careers of researchers; prevents adverse impact on patients and the public; promotes economic advancement; and prevents avoidable waste of resources.
